

SAMPLE INCENTIVE TRIP ITINERARY

DAY 1: BATH

<u>Morning</u>

Guided walking tour of Bath

An introduction to the city: Bath is a UNESCO World Heritage Site with lots to see and do. It is a compact city that is easy to explore on foot with the opportunity for thematic and historic tours plus the option to include the open top bus experience.

Visit the Assembly Rooms

The elegant and historic Assembly Rooms were designed in 1769. The world-renowned fashion museum is located on the ground floor.

<u>Afternoon</u>

Afternoon tea at the Pump Room

During your visit to the Pump Room you can try the hot spa water at the fountain. It contains 43 minerals and has a rather unusual taste!

The Holburne Museum

On the impressive approach to The Holburne Museum, the building's grand façade and gardens provide an inkling of its grandeur and history. The Grade I listed building was originally designed and constructed as a hotel but is now home to a collection of fine and decorative art. Available for private hire.

Evening

Private reception at the Roman Baths

The Grade I listed Roman Baths is Baths premier attraction. Dating back nearly 2,000 years, the Roman Baths offer a unique setting for a memorable event.

Dinner at the Royal Crescent Hotel

Situated on the famous Royal Crescent, the hotel offers a private setting with a country resort feel in the centre of Bath. The Royal Crescent Hotel offers an award-winning spa, 3 AA rosette restaurant, private gardens and 45 bedrooms and suites.



DAY 2: BATH & THE SURROUNDING AREAS

<u>Morning</u>

An experience at the exclusive Lucknam Park followed by lunch (experience examples – group horse riding, wine tasting, archery)

Multi award winning Lucknam Park is set in 500 acres of beautiful parkland, boasts 5* accommodation, a Michelin starred restaurant, brasserie, spa, an equestrian centre and four meeting rooms.

<u>Afternoon</u>

Experience the Thermae Bath Spa

Enjoy Britain's only natural thermal waters, as the Celts & Romans did over 2,000 years ago.

Evening

Dinner at the Gainsborough Hotel

Named after the artist Sir Thomas Gainsborough, the five-star hotel is centred around its luxurious Spa Village which has the exclusive privilege of having access to Bath's natural thermal, mineral-rich waters. The hotel offers 5* accommodation with 80 bedrooms and a 3 AA Rosette restaurant.

DAY 3: BRISTOL

<u>Morning</u>

Street art and spray tour

Experience Bristol's street art and learn how to spray your own canvas with a street art and spray tour in Banksy's home city and host destination to Upfest Europe's largest street art festival.

<u>Afternoon</u>

Lunch at Paco Taps

Lunch at Michelin starred Paco Tapas, located next to Bristol's harbourside.

Explore Brunel's SS Great Britain

Tour the world's first luxury cruise liner dating back to 1843. Visit to Being Brunel, an interactive museum celebrating the life of famed engineer Isambard Kingdom Brunel. Available for private evening hire.



Evening

Private reception at Clifton Observatory

This rooftop venue offers the perfect photo opportunity next to the famous Clifton Suspension Bridge.

Dinner at the Avon Gorge by Hotel du Vin

A stone's throw away from the Observatory and overlooking the Clifton Suspension Bridge and river Avon this boutique style hotel is ideal for private dining.

DAY 4 – BRISTOL & THE SURROUNDING AREAS

<u>Morning</u>

Experience at De Vere Tortworth Court

Outdoor activities followed by lunch on the grounds of De Vere Tortworth Court. A historic Grade II listed mansion located in South Gloucestershire.

<u>Afternoon</u>

Shopping

Take a shopping trip at Cribbs Causeway, Bristol's out of town shopping destination.

Evening

Hot air balloon flight

Take an early evening Champagne hot air balloon flight and take in the breath-taking views.

Dinner at Thornbury Castle

Stay and dine at Thornbury Castle, dating back to the 1500s and once owned by Henry VIII, Thornbury Castle has housed kings, queens and dukes over the centuries. Available for private hire
